### Show/Facility Rules

- Proper attire required, including safety vest for cross country, as well as an SCI certified helmet, to be worn at all times while mounted. Show attire is optional.
- USEA Rules apply- No readers for dressage.
- Ribbons to 8<sup>th</sup> place for overall and dressage phase.
- Show will take place rain or shine
- Breakfast and lunch available on show grounds.
- No alcoholic beverages on show grounds.
- All dogs must be on a leash, not allowed in clubhouse.
- FVSA is not responsible for any theft, accident or bodily injury.
- FVSA reserves the right to require stall rental if weather conditions preclude parking on the grass
